We appreciate that some families like to provide special goods to their loved ones, especially for Father's day.

We would like to remind you that only labelled (resident name & unit), prepackaged non-perishable, shelf storage foods such as biscuits, etc., will be allowed via the screening desk. We have limited communal storage for food items that require refrigeration for individual residents.
