Lyndoch Living – COVID-19 free – changes to visiting effective immediately

While Lyndoch Living remains COVID-19 free, our priority is to protect the health and wellbeing of our residents, clients, team, and the broader community.

As announced by the Premier of Victoria today, the State of Victoria will move to statewide Circuit Breaker Action restrictions as of 11:59pm this evening. This means you must stay at home unless:

- Shopping for necessary goods and services (one person per household, once per day, a support person can accompany if required)
- Caregiving or compassionate reasons
- Essential work or permitted education
- Exercise (can leave for two hours of exercise)

We are now implementing the following visitor restrictions to all our homes, effective immediately:


- A precautionary closure to all visitors, apart from those providing end-of-life care. For those providing essential care, e.g. supporting responsive behaviours and compassionate care, please contact the Nurse Unit Manager.

We regret any inconvenience and anxiety that this may cause some residents and their families, and ask for your support and understanding. We understand that keeping in touch with family and friends is important. As an alternative to physically visiting our homes, please consider telephoning your family member, or using a social media app to have a virtual visit. Our staff are happy to assist in connecting you with your loved one via phone, FaceTime or window visits.
