## Re: COVID-19 update

We write to provide you with an update on the current active COVID-19 cases at Lyndoch Living.

In total, we have six resident cases of COVID-19, all located within the Riverside unit (Harris and Berlyn wing). The affected residents continue to do well, are fully vaccinated and are receiving anti-viral medication. We continue to notify these residents' primary contact with updated daily information via phone.

We continue to implement all necessary actions for infection prevention and control and we are closely monitoring these affected residents and all other residents. We will keep you updated. Thank you, as always, for your support during this time.

At Lyndoch Living, we take every precaution possible to care for our residents – your loved ones. Our Infection Prevention and Control Coordinator is in contact with the local Public Health Unit daily. Our team strictly adhere to PPE requirements to minimise the risk of further infection.

The Riverside Unit remains as a red zone, and we request all partners-in-care visitors for essential care needs to:

- Only visit when you are well, are not a close contact or positive COVID-19 case
- Complete, and return, a negative rapid antigen test (RAT) before entry in our Home
- Comply with the Tier 2 (amber zone) or Tier 3 (red zone) PPE requirements and follow the instructions of the screening and care teams at Lyndoch Living
- Practice social distancing, hand hygiene and wear a N95 mask at all times
- Only visit in the resident's room and, where possible, ensure windows are open to provide natural ventilation (do not remove your PPE)
- Book your visit online and check in upon arrival
